Payment Terms and Options

School Fee Statements are emailed out to all families at the start of each term. Payment Terms are 14 days from the date of your Statement. For those families that wish to pay upfront in one payment for the whole year, a **\$50 discount** will be deducted from the total amount owing. Payment must be made by the due date of Term 1 fees for the annual payment discount to be applied.

Payment Options include Direct Debit or Credit Card Authority, BPay, Eftpos, Cash or Cheque. Direct Debit and Credit Card Authority forms are available from the office, on the school website or Parent Portal.

A new Direct Debit or Credit Card Authority form must be completed each year.

Families unable to make payments by the due date must make arrangements with the Principal. Where reminder notices are ignored or arrangements to pay arrears are not kept, the school will pursue legal action to recover outstanding fees.

The school is supportive of families in difficult financial circumstances and a concessions process is available for families. A new application must be submitted at the start of each school year and application forms are available on the school portal.

Explanation of Fees and Levies

School Fees	These fees are calculated based on the recommendation of Brisbane Catholic Education. School Fees cover the recurrent costs of the school. Examples include salary and wages, council rates, water, electricity, phone, insurance.
Capital Levy	This is a compulsory levy charged per family. It is used to help meet the maintenance and refurbishment costs of current facilities together with contributions to the cost of current and future commitments of building projects
P&F Levy	This levy has been determined by the St William's Parents and Friends Advisory Group and is used to assist the school to improve resources and facilities. Funds also contribute to school events run by the Group.
Student Levy	This levy includes but not limited to: Costs of classroom consumable items Teaching resources and equipment Excursions and Incursions Swimming lessons in Term 4 Learning Subscriptions Athletics & Swimming Zone & District Levies
Booklist Levy	This levy covers the booklist items (eg stationery) that are delivered to the school in bulk at the start of the school year. This levy is charged in Term 1 only.
IT Access Levy	This levy relates to the purchase and maintenance of digital technologies, software, infrastructure and equipment (including school owned iPad devices).
Gala Sports Levy	Gala sport for Years 3 to 6 held normally in Term 3 (however circumstances may change this date) and forms part of the school sports program. The levy is used to offset the cost of buses and hire of fields to the relevant sporting grounds.
Instrumental Music Program	The music program is an extra-curricular program and is open to Years 4 to 6 students to participate in lessons, which includes being part of our Junior and Senior school bands.
Application Fee	This non-refundable fee covers the processing costs of the initial enrolment application.
Prep and Year 1 to 6 Confirmation Fee	This non-refundable fee guarantees a place in the respective year level and covers the associated costs of enrolling and onboarding new students (including the Pathway to Prep program).

Voluntary Building Fund and Library Fund Donations

Families are encouraged to make a donation to the Building Fund to allow us to plan more confidently for much needed maintenance and building projects. The Library Fund will support the acquisition of additional books, library shelving and equipment.

Contributions to these funds are voluntary and are tax deductible. Tax receipts are issued to families each year in July. The school is very appreciative of all contributions to these funds.
